We have an outdoor regulation size pool and a wading pool and started using Heatsavr in 2009.

Seeing heatsavr advertised in a recreation publication we wondered if this could actually do what it claimed, save on chemical and dollars for heating the water. With some doubt it was decided to try a case.

The first thing that was noted was in the morning when temperatures are lower there was not the steam/ evaporation coming off of the water as we had seen before. So if this was the case then the probability of it working maybe was true.

We manually add the heatsavr at night when the pool closes and have seen a significant difference in the amount of chemical that needs to be added. We have checked our billing for natural gas it was far less but we had problems with our heater so this year will be the test, a new heater was installed, so with the heater and the heatsavr there should be tremendous savings. If we added the automatic metering I believe the saving would also gain.

I would recommend this product to anyone and see for yourself the benefits and savings.
